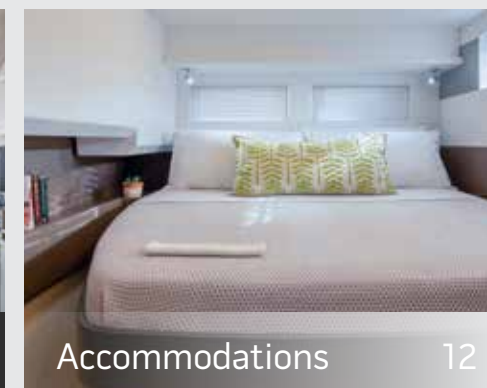

OUTDOOR LIVING

The outside cockpit areas are an extension of the interior, all uniting to create a feeling of space and airiness.

The forward end of the saloon opens onto a sunny lounging area, complete with adjustable recliners.

The aft cockpit is a simple, well proportioned U-shaped settee with a large dining table sized to seat eight comfortably.

The flybridge adds a whole alternative seating area and can be used while underway or as an elevated position to enjoy sundowners or even a light meal at anchor.

The main helm station is situated in the flybridge area, and provides a large comfortable seating position, with a commanding all-round view.

The flybridge space is protected by a composite-moulded hardtop, which has a newly incorporated "spoiler" along its aft end to reduce excessive turbulence from entering the aft flybridge sundeck when underway.

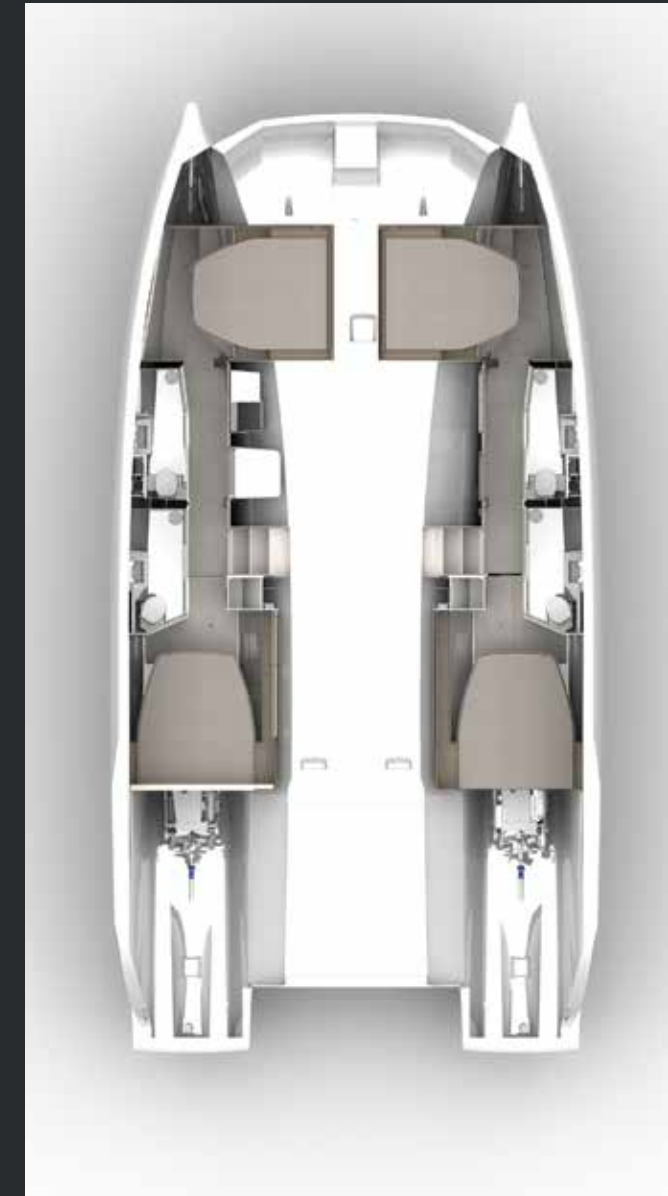
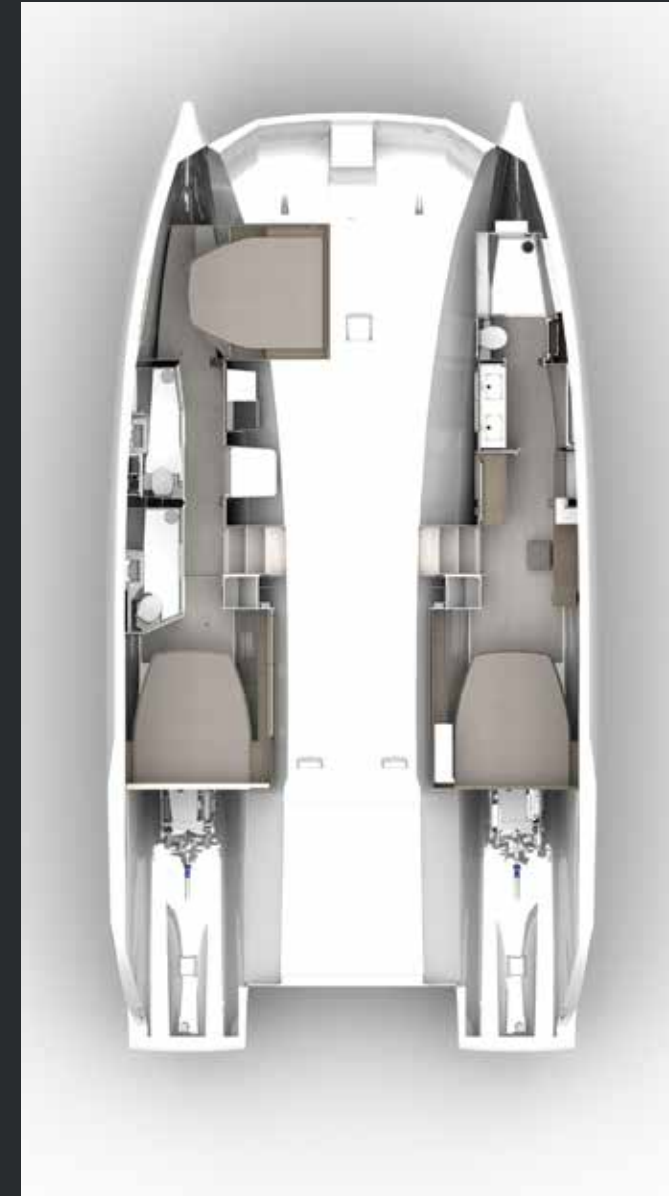
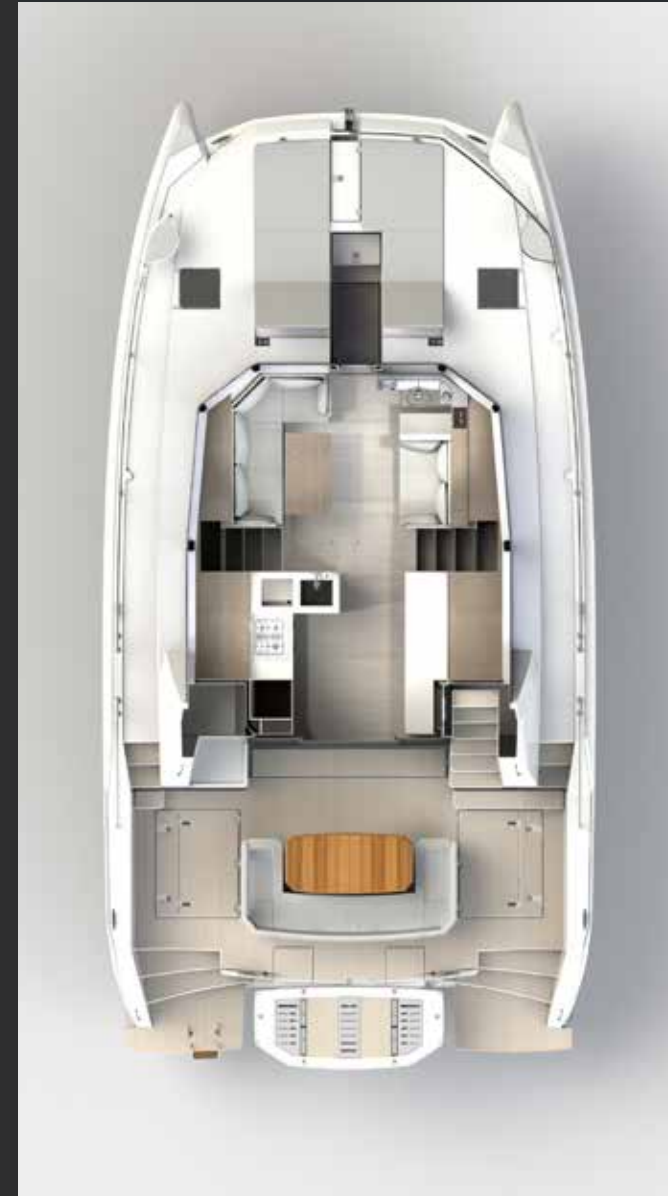
The Leopard 46 Powercat comes in a three or four-cabin layout, with the option for separate crew cabins.
